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Seminar Report on "Research in Algae for Biodiesel Formulation"

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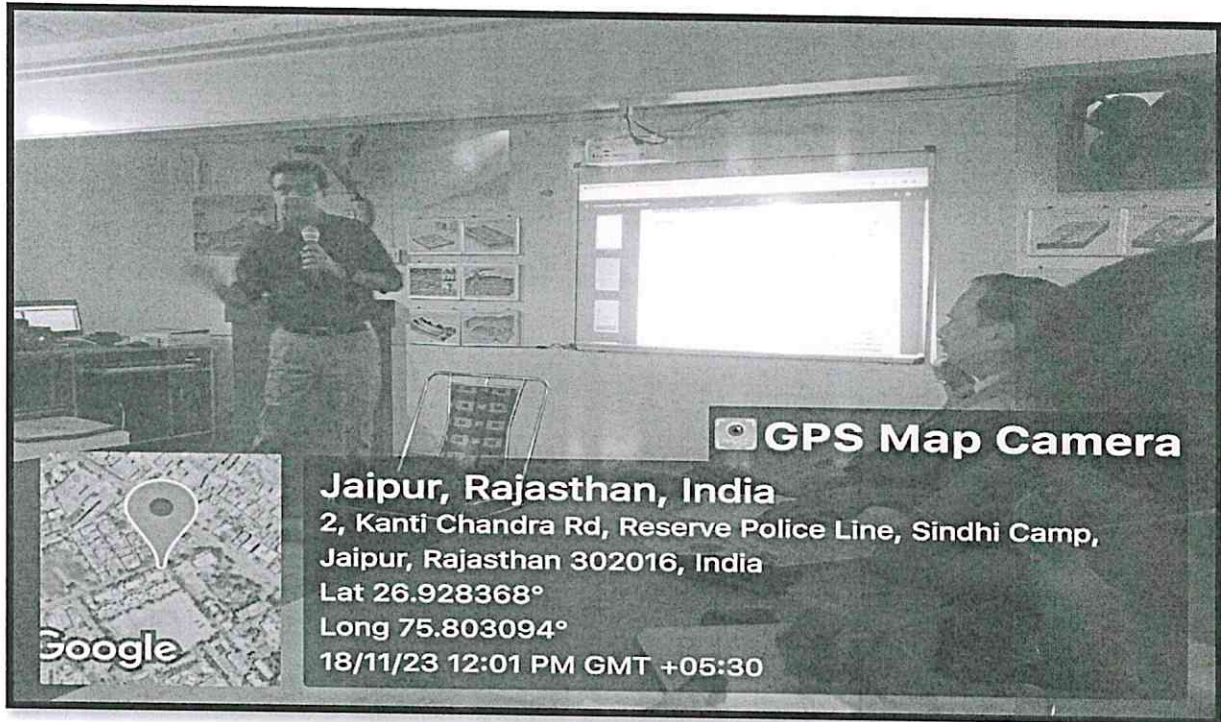
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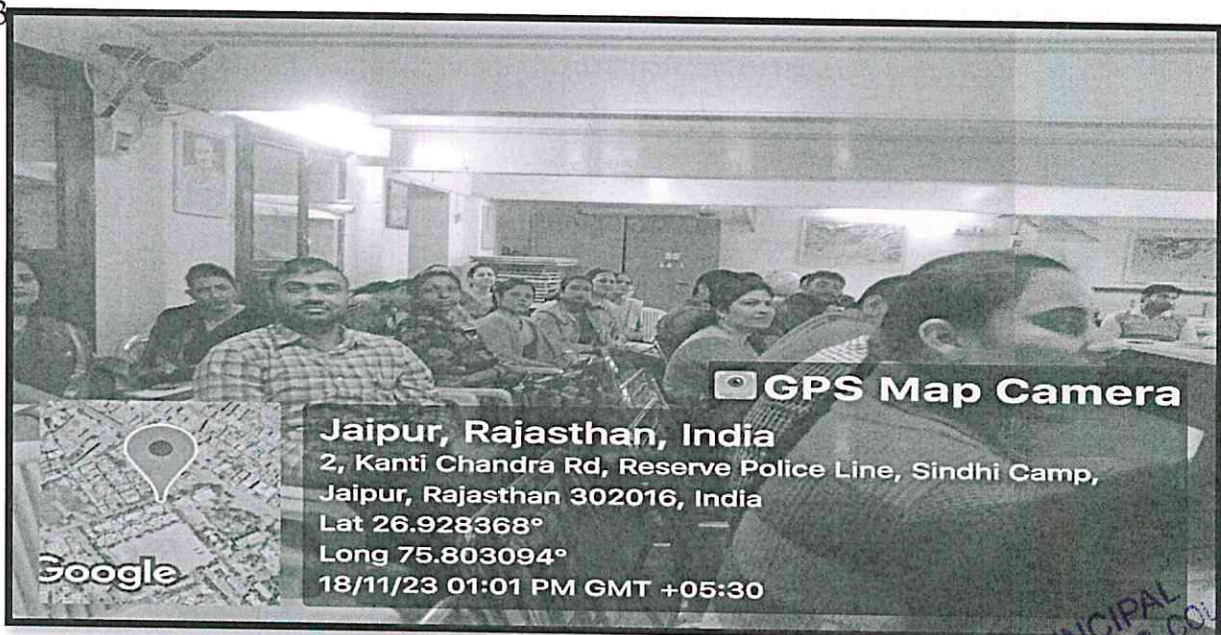
